

Overview of Flexible Tuition

at The Outdoor Academy

We strive to make a semester at The Outdoor Academy available to the widest possible range of students. All parents/guardians will pay something towards their student's education at OA. Some cover the full cost of tuition, while the majority do not have this ability. We aim to mitigate the costs of tuition in our operations whenever possible. Additionally, we allocate approximately 10% of our total annual tuition income towards financial assistance in addition to funds generously provided through endowment.

For the 2025-26 school year, we have committed to resetting our maximum tuition. We want to step outside of the annual steady increase in independent school tuition and have our published price more accurately reflect what most families actually pay. Our flexible tuition model works in many ways like a sliding scale, and we hope that all interested students will be able to pursue this opportunity without a price tag impeding the process.

SOME USEFUL NOTES ABOUT OUR PROCESS

- Any student regardless of race, color, creed, national or ethnic origin may apply.
- Admissions at OA is "need blind" decisions will **not** be influenced by financial need.
- Tuition requests are reviewed **after** a student has completed their application. We aim to provide you with a decision in a timely manner following your student's acceptance.
- Any monies awarded by The Outdoor Academy are in the form of a grant, i.e. they
 do not need to be repaid. Due to finite resources that must support many students, we
 cannot accommodate every request, nor will your discount cover the entire cost of tuition.
- For students at tuition-charging schools: If you attend an independent school, please inquire with your school regarding their policies on tuition remission and transference of financial aid for your semester. We are happy to provide you with more information or clarification on how to begin these conversations.

We base our decisions on this Request, your PFS report, and the suitability of the applicant at OA as demonstrated in the application process.
